MEETING DATE AND TIME/ATTENDEES:

Meeting was held via teleconference on Thursday, April 4, 2019 at 9:00 – 9:45 pm EST

Attendees: Link Ginger McKnight-Chavers, Link Marilyn Price

Arts Facet Meeting Dates (as needed & subject to reschedule): September 11, 2018; October 15 (rescheduled from October 9), 2018; November 12, 2018 (rescheduled from November 13); December 11, 2018; January 8, 2019; February 12, 2019; March 12, 2019; April 4, 2019 (rescheduled from April 9, 2019).

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

1. In an Arts State of Mind in collaboration with the Wartburg & the Clay Arts Center.
 1. Link Ginger discussed proposal suggested by NTS to reduce our combined investment in In an Arts State of Mind from \$3,500 to \$2,000 in light of both facets' significant budget decreases next program year. Link Hillary from NTS suggested that since each session costs us \$250, we decrease the Clay Arts sessions to 8 rather than 12, and have 4 Links-led sessions that are "Days of Pampering" or the like.
 2. We agreed that this is a good idea and would like Link Earlene's input and suggestions. Link Marilyn suggested we also consider cutting out summer sessions or asking Link Earlene if she felt comfortable and interested in leading some of the pottery sessions herself.
2. Java and Jazz, Surf Club, New Rochelle, May 19, 2019
 1. A fifth artist vendor, Khalid Sabree, has agreed to participate. Link Ginger and Link Michelle are proceeding to put together artist agreement for him to sign.
3. Young Master Writers Competition (National)
 1. Link Ginger submitted necessary paperwork and poems of our entrant, Jordan Williams of Valhalla High School, to the Area's Young Master Writers Competition, and received confirmation of receipt from the Area.
4. CTA: Classics Through the Ages (National)
 1. Link Ginger did not receive responses from the Mt Vernon performing arts high school and, when we have greater attendance at facet meeting, request suggestions for potential arts partners with a goal to engaging a new partner in the fall. Link Marilyn suggested we also reach out to ITS re any students or groups that may fit into the program parameters, and request information from Link Lisa re the New Rochelle High School program and administrator she connected with re past DTH event.
5. Broadway theater event 5/22/19
 1. Link Ginger submitted a chapter check for 30 student and 3 chaperone tickets for the Broadway show, Be More Chill, for our May 22 Broadway student outing. Tickets are being held at the box office.
6. College Tour
 1. STY has not yet reached out to us regarding assistance or a contribution for the proposed Philadelphia college tour. Link Ginger will obtain more details during the upcoming Executive Committee meeting.
