ISSUES DISCUSSED:

1. In an Arts State of Mind in collaboration with the Wartburg & the Clay Arts Center.
 1. Link Marilyn attended the March session and reported three Links were in attendance and 7-8 residents. Successful session where bowls were made and decorated. A new instructor was in attendance. A couple of new Wartburg staff stayed on throughout the session and joined in and helped with the activity.
 2. Link Ginger will follow up re timing of whether Arts Facet financial contribution to IASOM comes out of the current budget or the next program year – believe the next program year but will confirm.
2. Java and Jazz, Surf Club, New Rochelle, May 19, 2019
 1. All artists have signed contracts and exhibition by our National Poster Arts competition winner confirmed. Links Ginger and Michelle will follow up with potential additional artists they reached out to and follow up with artists regarding a potential walk-through of the space.
3. Young Master Writers Competition (National)
 1. Link MaryFrances confirmed that Link Terry reached out to student poet, who will be providing three poems. Link Terry is obtaining the permission forms and other documents from the young lady's parents and teachers and will provide for us to submit to national by 3/15.
4. CTA: Classics Through the Ages (National)
 1. We did not discuss during the call. Link Ginger circulated an email immediately following the conference call updating the Facet that she had not received a response from the Mt Vernon performing arts high school and requesting facet members to follow up with suggested arts partners mentioned during last meeting and provide other suggestions for us to discuss at the next meeting.
5. Broadway theater event 5/22/19
 1. Link Ginger looked into alternatives to To Kill A Mockingbird, which is sold out for months. Only suitable alternatives she found were Lion King and Ain't Too Proud. She followed up with Aint Too Proud box office and found that they can accommodate the group with student tickets.
 2. Link Priscilla informed the facet regarding a new Broadway show, Be More Chill, that the facet agreed seemed to be a better alternative and perfect for the students' demographic. Link Ginger confirmed that she would follow up with the box office to see if the group could be accommodated on May 22.
