5. a play or musical on Broadway to take a group of students [in partnership with International Trends and Services Facet] (Facet considered Lynn Nottage's new play, Sweat, but it's run has ended. Facet will discuss when we may take students to see a play, possibly Winter/Spring 2017-18. Facet members are thinking of resources to help underwrite the Facet's ability to take students to see the Broadway musical Hamilton.
