- Highlights about the role of our Chapter members on the National stage were discussed. Our Chapter was well represented. Link Dawna & Colgate hosted the service project and hundreds of people attended. Link Dawna introduced some of the speakers at one of the luncheons. Link Earlene was on a conference luncheon agenda and gave awards for an AARP contest. Link Joyce organized the entire Legacy Luncheon agenda. She and her husband provided the funds for the Morgan State Choir fly out to La Vegas to sing at the luncheon. Each of the past National presidents spoke and the choir sang in between each speaker.

- Link Traci and Link Lisa have been working hard on the Taraji Henson Fundraiser. Link Dianne is asking each Chapter member to purchase two VIP tickets. Link Dianne thanked all of the members who attended the Fundraiser Committee meeting.
- This is the last year for the current administration. An Executive Council Meeting was held. The Council consists of the six elected officials, parliamentarian, and program coordinator. The Council discussed the 2016-2017 goals and asked each Council member to submit their goals to Link Dianne.

 - Approve payment of 30% of the total costs to the caterer

 - Keep ticket price to \$135 sell 6
- Link Terry discussed a possible partnership with the Delta's in January for a movie premier. Our contribution would be for continental breakfast. We would keep revenue from tickets we sell.
