The National Nominating Committee released an updated version of the Nominating Procedures Manual on last Thursday, October 11, 2018. Based on the comments and feedback received from the membership, the deadline to file your *Profile of Candidate for Nomination Form* has been extended to **11:59 p.m. on Wednesday, October 31, 2018.**

Please note that all Profile of Candidate for Nomination forms must be submitted electronically with president approval and chapter endorsement, and candidate fee paid on or before, **11:59 p.m. on October 31, 2018.**

The difference between Ethical issues vs membership issues was reviewed. Also received a review of the finances from National Treasurer, Ethelyn S. Bowers.

9/ February 20, 2019 - Deadline for non-DOL and reinstatement candidate profiles to be submitted in the online candidate system.

10/ March 31, 2018 - Deadline for submission of Alumna request forms and letters.

11/ April 1, 2019 - Building assessment deadline for all 2016 inductees.

12/ April 1, 2019 - Deadline for all 2019-2020 membership dues to be processed, submitted and approved online.

13/ May 1, 2019 - Deadline for receipt of late dues, assessments, and fees for non-financial members processed online.
