Programming Plan and Service Opportunities

Services to Youth will once again offer two signature programs during 2017-2018:

1. Young Achievers and Young Explorers Program providing a continuum of services to prepare historically underrepresented high school boys of color for selective college admissions.

- **Program topics include but not limited to: College Night; Leadership Skills; Career Info/Interviewing; Dress for Success; Real Talk (men only); Business Meal Etiquette; and Financial Literacy**
- **Field trips for all participants in spring 2018 may include IBM Watson, college visits, and museum. STATUS: PLANNING STAGES**

- Continue intensive monthly programming for 11 & 12th grade boys at New Rochelle HS. October 2017 to June 2018. This group is called "Young Achievers." Information session Wednesday, Sept. 27 at NRHS
- Extend (age appropriate) components of the intensive programming to 9th & 10th grade boys at NRHS. This group is called "Young Explorers." Facet will determine which activities best suited for this group prior to upcoming information session families on Wednesday, Sept 27 at NRHS
