Discussion

1. Should scholarships be limited to students from our partner schools?

Pros: helps to deepen our relationship with partner schools and counselors in those schools

Cons: excludes worthy students from other schools/community organizations

Decision: limit to partner schools

2. Should preference for HBCUs be written on the application?

Pros: aligns with national Initiative on HBCUs

Cons: sends message that may deter students who cannot leave town to attend college

Decision: do not indicate preference for HBCU attendees. Committee can use its discretion when deciding on awardees.
